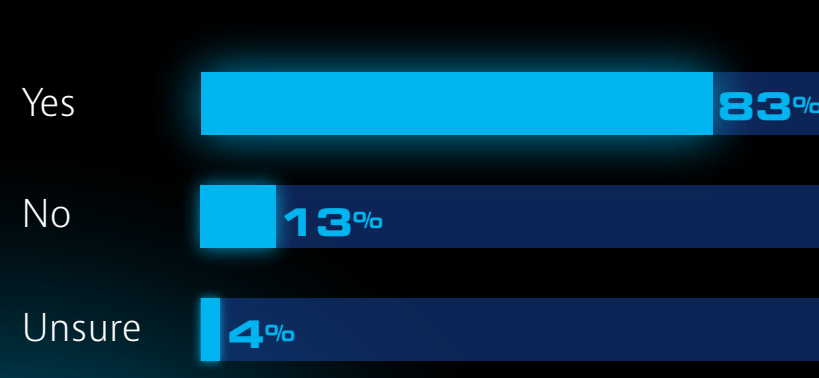

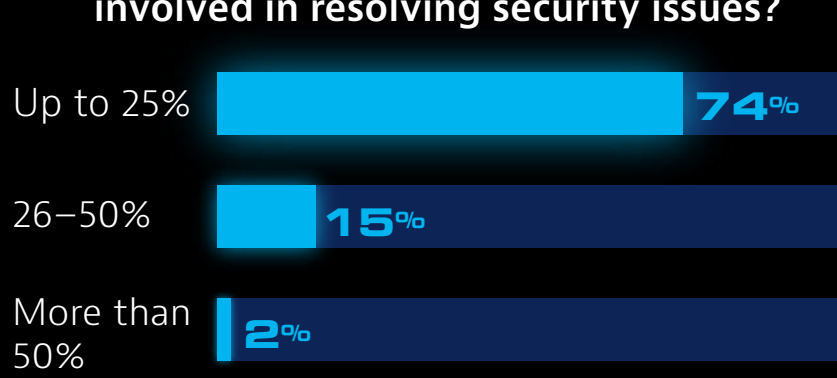

Is your organization's network team involved in resolving security issues?

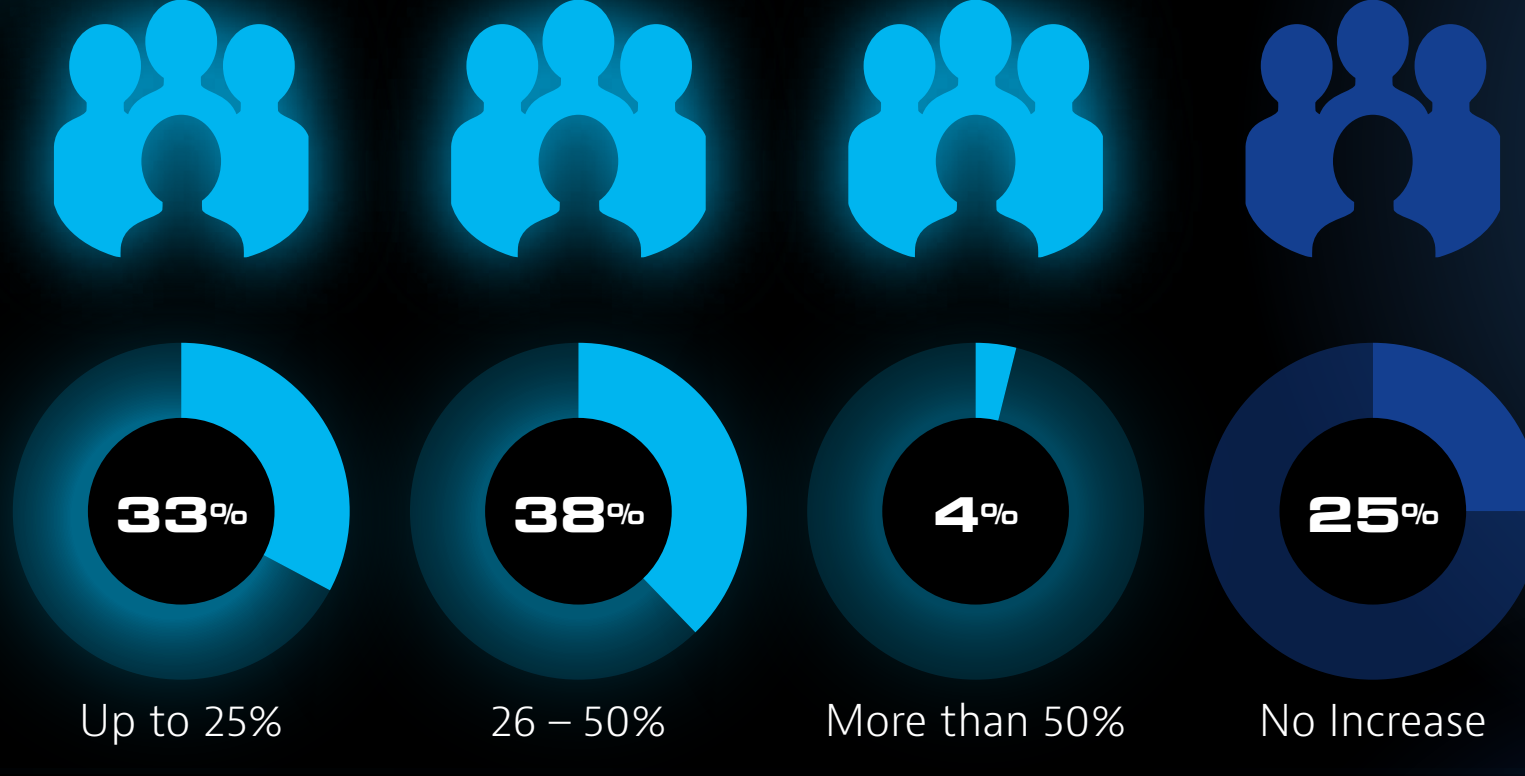


What percent of a 40 hour work week is your organization's network team involved in resolving security issues?

3 OF 4 Report Significant Growth

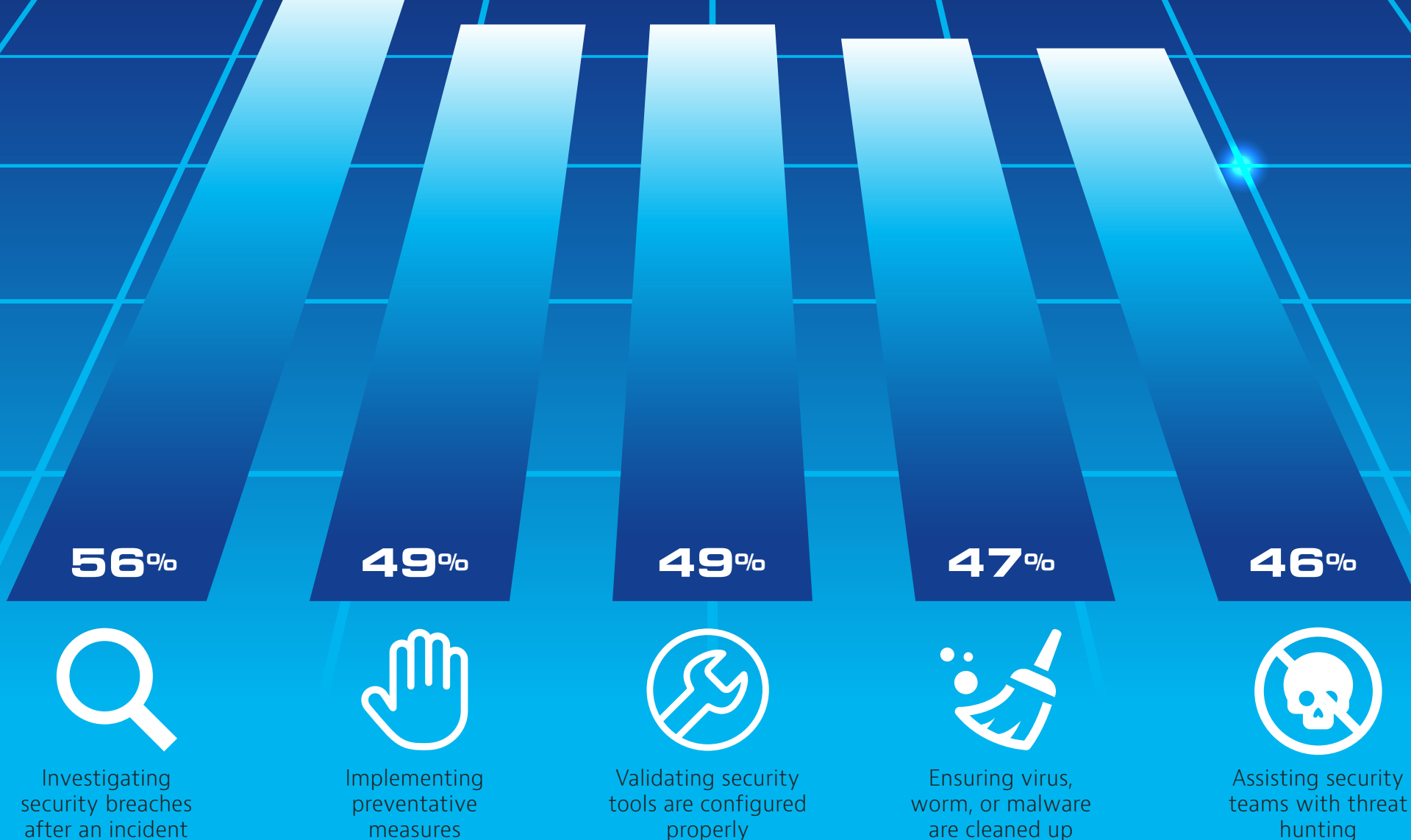


IT TEAMS OBSERVE INCREASE IN FREQUENCY AND SOPHISTICATION OF THREATS



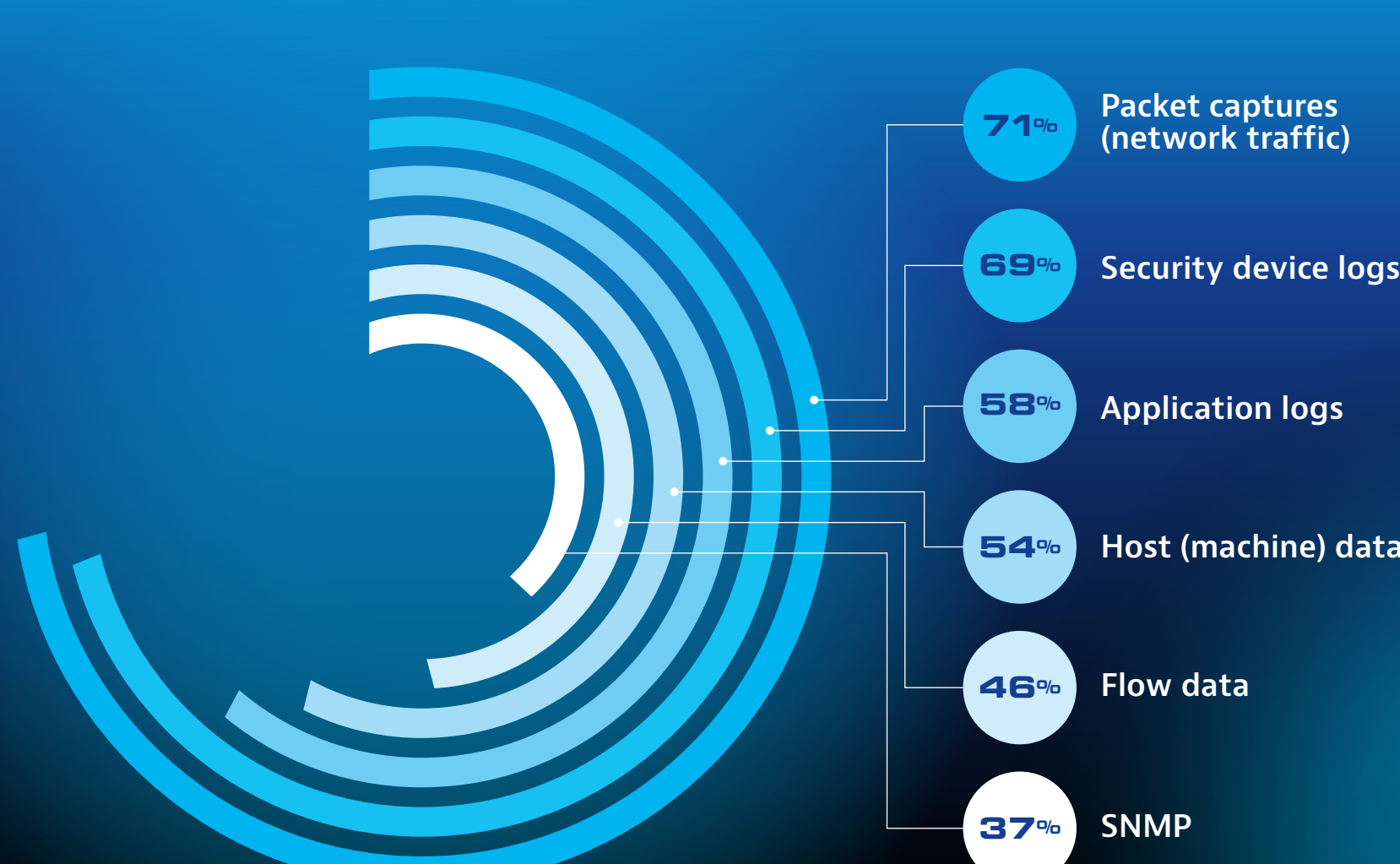

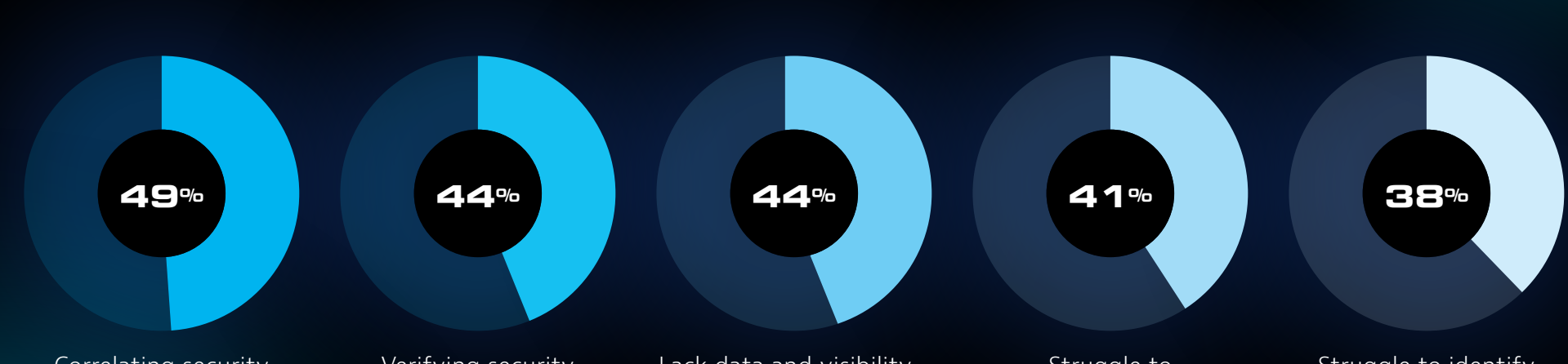

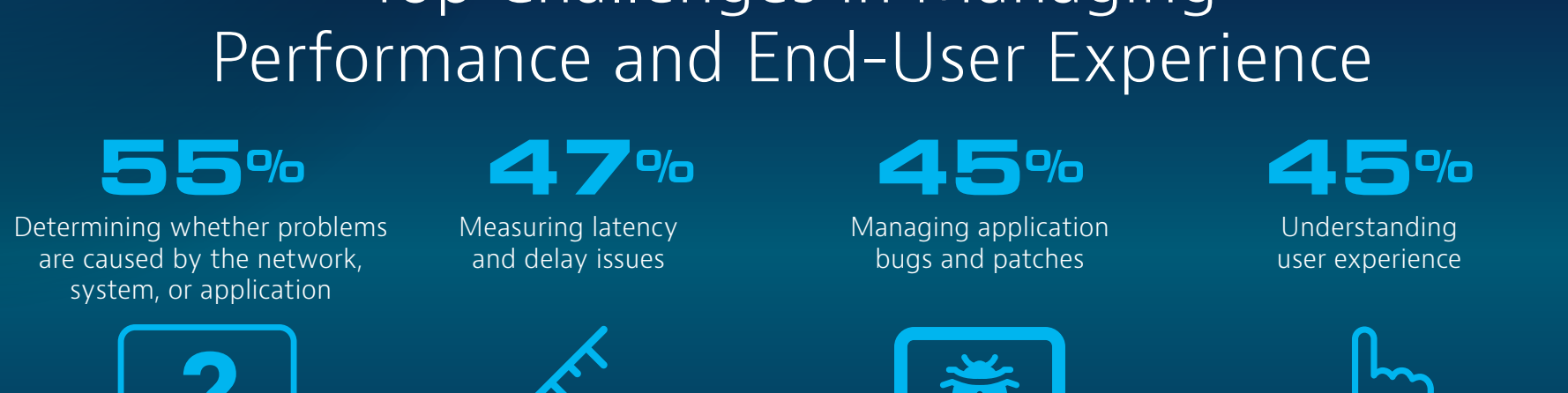
